MESSAGE FROM MISS SAUL

Happy Friday, Team Ipsley! This week has been a busy one for us in school!

Year 6 took a trip to Shrewsbury Prison this week, as they have been looking at the theme of injustice in their history work. Our pupils enjoyed their time visiting a Victorian Prison, finding out about, and even taking part in, some of the punishments the inmates would have been given! They also experienced a special guided tour with a prison officer and visited the cells! An amazing and unusual experience for our pupils which helped them think about justice and empathy.

KS2 took part in their own General Election this week with volunteers sharing the various party manifestos. After a couple of sessions of campaigning, an intense poster campaign and even party political broadcasts, the children in Years 5 and 6 entered their votes into the ballot box at lunchtime on Thursday. Everyone got involved as we learned about our democratic process. Matching the national result our vote was won by Labour who took 43% of the votes with the Green Party in second place.

On Thursday we had two great events in school: Sports Day and our Summer Concert. Sports Day was great fun for all, with a real mix of athletic and fun activities – from the 100 meters and long jump to the egg and spoon race and welly wanging! The Summer Concert was excellent as our incredible choir and talented musicians performed for their parents. We had drums, keyboard and guitar solos and three songs from the choir. Both of these events were a great showcase for our talented pupils but what I was most impressed with was how supportive of each other the pupils were. From the loud cheers of support from the crowds at Sports Day and the race participants congratulating each other as they finished their races, to the whispers of: 'You got this!' from the choir to the solo artists in the Summer Concert – it made me so proud to see what kind and supportive pupils we have who delight in seeing others do well!



COLLECTIVE WORSHIP

This week in Collective Worship we focussed on our value of **resilience**. We looked in detail at the times in the Bible where Moses didn't give up – even after some events that may have made him feel very discouraged!

Pupils reflected on the times when they sometimes feel like giving up – when their team is losing in sports, when their work is challenging, when they get beaten in the final level of their computer game or when they just can't see the next steps they need to take in any situation!

From hearing the story of Moses, pupils reflected that you have to accept that sometimes things don't go your way the first time and that sometimes you have to try different approaches or ways of doing things. They know that sometimes you have to fail to succeed - to FAIL is your First Attempt In Learning.
