














MESSAGE FROM MISS SAUL

As our first full week of the academic year comes to an end, we have so much to tell you about our lessons this week!

Mr Hylton and Mrs Field were delighted this week when 5JH started cheering when they found out they were going to the library for their weekly library lesson! Year 5 have impressed us with how much they enjoy reading and they have loved finding about Hercules, Cerberus and Hydra in their reading lessons this week.

Year 8 have been working out how developed they think countries are using different development indicators. They had to use oracy skills to debate which countries they thought were more or less developed, explaining their reasons to their groups!

Both Year 7 and 8 have been totally absorbed in their Philosophy and Ethics lessons this week. Year 8 have been discussing human rights and trying to decide which ones are the most important – not an easy task and one which prompted plenty of debate. Year 7 have been discussing difficult questions – such as: 'Is it ever ok to steal?' and really looking deeply at their own values.

Year 6 have been learning about static electricity and having great fun using balloons to help them understand this more deeply. They have also been using maps to look more closely at William the Conqueror, the castles he built and why he chose the positions for them that he did!

In PE, pupils have competed the bleep test and have been learning about how fitness is linked to several careers they may be looking at for their futures.

It has been a wonderful week in school and our pupils have earned their weekend!






SCHOOL CLOSES TO PUPILS ON THURSDAY 24TH OCTOBER
